Financial Updates

EPABID has \$60,000 in Wells Fargo, about \$30,000 came in from assessments. Some properties still owe from last year. Univest has \$109k - \$85,000 is from recently deposited Samuel & Sons for the CDC grant.

OPA Adjustments - Two properties had their Assessments reduced. Board discussed how to handle our side of previous years that the City reassessed. Stated at the meeting we would give the credit to the current two property owners. We should establish language and policy that clarifies the line in assessment invoice for any other properties moving forward.

We are planning a virtual meeting for yearly audit in April or May. Adam is going to send out letters to owners informing them of meeting once we pick a date

General Updates and Discussions

a. Committee Update- Adam Geer on Police Hiring

The police Department is understaffed by approx 1,300 Officers due to hiring challenges as well as retirement, off duty police. Communities are missing police. Adam questions policy of having to live in the City for a year before hiring. Does not make sense for the current need. We need to deal with many problems throughout the City especially in Black and Brown neighborhoods. Can we press the issue to City Council? Could the BID write a letter to Council to appeal/adjust amendment? Maybe all the BIDs in the City could all write a letter as a group. Adam G. presenting to BID Alliance group on 17th.

A division of Penn has a design dept.-use of public space, street scape, etc. maybe they can do some work and not charge. Private Developer- maybe we can have a hand. The BID can send out surveys.

g. Directional Signage

Michelle did research on directional signs 2-4 signs-metal case would open to change map and advertising, double sided. Wide range of pricing (\$1,800 - \$3,000 per sign depending on features and materials) and experience from contacts in Philadelphia and NJ — May make sense to get official quotes or regroup with Adam and others.
