Space Planning, Health, and Safety Updates

There was a trip and fall claim at Gateway, Adam was served legal papers. It happened March 2019. Adam in contact with insurance and will keep Pam and Adam G. looped in.

Chase has been stationing security guards for the individuals staying overnight in the ATM. Adam and neighbors are consistently contacting outreach for homeless support. This a city-wide problem, but working to address it. Still problems with Watts Street, Broad & Snyder, and 2033 Broad the old McDonalds.

Updates for string lights – Chris the electrician has been out sick and needs some recovery time, but updates will be addressed.

Wind last week pushed Gabriella's streetery into street. Adam, neighbors, and police officer pushed it back. The owners said they are probably going to remove it.

Feedback from streeteries legislation by City-frustrating for many restaurants, especially smaller ones with less seating. Large costs associated with proposed fees and requirements. We have been speaking with BID Alliance and Councilmember Domb's office about requests to amend the City legislation to make it more considerate to small business.

Some of the restaurants streeteries are expected to be coming down. Adam asked if there might be a problem getting rid of materials used for streeteries, if the material is still good and could be re-used. Marlo said she knew a group that would recycle it.
