1. Financial Updates

- a. Estimated total expenses from EPMF -\$32,190.88. No bill from Mark Beyerle to come, his fees are paid through his portal by individual businesses via rental/permit fees.
- Assessments: Update from Ann Lastuvka, former Director of Operations for Northern Liberties BID regarding old debt, cleaning up QuickBooks, processing liens, etc. Report sent to board in email on
 - i. 10 very delinquent properties. \$900 lawyer fee on each to be reimbursed on payment of assessment. First a letter will go out to property outlining plan of action/fees. Next step is court filing. The eventual long-term result will be the sheriff's sale of property. Letter by lawyer is free, \$900 is court filing fee. Also, the lawyer receives 18% the property owner pays. 2 different letters drafted one a "sledgehammer" for very delinquent properties, one milder for special circumstances, more recent delinquencies.
